Background

Our population is being impacted more and more by complex, long term conditions. There is a growing concern about areas of longstanding unmet health needs and the social determinants of health are playing a bigger role than ever before.

We want to be able to provide additional support for roles which fall into the Additional Roles Reimbursement Scheme (ARRS) through interactive Peer Support sessions.

Programme Outline

We are offering short, themed, online sessions to help build a community of support. They are facilitator led, interactive spaces, for people to come together, share their experiences and be heard. The aim of the sessions is to reduce any feelings of professional isolation and to create greater levels of connection, collaboration and support

Wellbeing will be a strand running throughout all the sessions and the key focus of the sessions is:

- Starting well and keeping going
- Finding my place
- Understanding how change impacts on me
- Next Steps/The Future
